Community Health Assist Scheme (CHAS)

Enjoy **subsidies** at participating private clinics near your home

Seniors' Mobility and Enabling Fund (SMF)

Seniors can remain mobile and live more independently with the help of up to **90% subsidies** for assistive devices

Pioneer Generation Disability Assistance Scheme (PioneerDAS)

Pioneers with moderate or severe disabilities can receive **\$100 a month** to help with their care needs

Caregivers Training Grant (CTG)

Learn how to better care for your loved ones with a **\$200 training subsidy each year**

Foreign Domestic Worker (FDW) Levy Concession for Persons with Disabilities

When you employ an FDW to look after a frail senior or loved one with disabilities, you pay a **lower levy of \$60 a month**



6

Foreign Domestic Worker (FDW) Grant

When you hire an FDW to care for your loved ones with moderate to severe disabilities, you receive **\$120 a month**

All ages can qualify

For households with income	For households with no income
-----------------------------------	--------------------------------------

Household monthly income per person must be \$1,800 and below

$$\text{Household monthly income per person} = \frac{\text{Total gross household monthly income}}{\text{Total number of family members living together}}$$

Annual Value (AV)* of home must be \$21,000 and below

(*AV is assessed by IRAS. An AV of up to \$21,000 covers all HDB flats and some lower-value private residences.)

			
Household monthly income per person	\$1,100 and below	\$1,101 to \$1,800	All Pioneers receive Pioneer Generation subsidies under CHAS, regardless of income or AV of home
Annual Value (AV) of home for households with no income	\$13,000 and below	\$13,001 to \$21,000	

Pioneers are encouraged to apply for CHAS to enjoy higher subsidies at Public Hospital Specialist Outpatient Clinics (SOCs).



Seniors' Mobility and Enabling Fund (SMF) for Assistive Devices

Eligibility Criteria:



Singapore Citizens



Aged 60 and above



Household monthly income per person must be \$1,800 and below

Subject to assessment by a qualified assessor to determine type and suitability of assistive devices for the applicant.

Pioneer Generation Disability Assistance Scheme (PioneerDAS)

Eligibility Criteria:

Pioneer living in Singapore

Born before 1950

Became a Singapore Citizen before 1987

Needs permanent help with 3 or more Activities of Daily Living (ADLs)



Bathing



Dressing



Eating



Toileting



Walking or moving around



Transferring

4 Caregivers Training Grant (CTG)



Eligibility Criteria:

Care Recipient

Singapore Citizens or Permanent Residents	Aged 65 and above	OR	Has a disability as certified by a Singapore-registered doctor if below 65 years of age

5 Foreign Domestic Worker (FDW) Levy Concession for Persons with Disabilities



6 Foreign Domestic Worker (FDW) Grant

Eligibility Criteria:

Foreign Domestic Worker (FDW) Levy Concession for Persons with Disabilities

Care recipient must be a Singapore Citizen
Aged between 16 and 64 years old
Needs permanent help with at least 1 ADL

Foreign Domestic Worker (FDW) Grant

Care recipient must be a Singapore Citizen	For care recipient who is a Permanent Resident, the FDW employer must be a Singapore Citizen
No age criteria for Singapore Citizens	Aged 65 and above for Permanent Residents
Needs permanent help with at least 3 ADLs	

FDW employer must be a family member living together with care recipient at the same NRIC-registered address

No income criteria
Not necessary for FDW to attend caregivers' training

Monthly household income per person must be \$2,600 and below. If household has no income, the annual value of your property must be less than \$13,000
FDW must attend caregivers' training that is approved by AIC
